



Conservation on the Farm (Lantra Accredited Training)

Description: This full day Lantra accredited course ‘Conservation on the Farm’ aims to deliver a unique learning experience of why and how to farm for nature. It is delivered over one day with a mix of classroom activities and a farm visit. The farm visit will show examples of what other farmers are doing and how it benefits them and wildlife alike. This course is recommended for all those either working in or pursuing a career in agriculture and ties in well with other courses such as GCSE in Agriculture or Level 2 and 3 Diploma’s in Work Based Agriculture. The course is catered towards young farmers and has a maximum capacity of 20 participants per session .
