

Location filming on Ulster Wildlife Nature Reserves

Ulster Wildlife is a local nature conservation charity. As part of our efforts to protect and restore nature, we manage a suite of nature reserves across Northern Ireland. From time to time we receive requests to film on our sites.

As well as being havens for wildlife, many of our nature reserves offer stunning landscapes and may provide the perfect backdrop for your documentary, TV series or film.

In order to ensure that your filming is done safely and does not impact our nature reserves, a staff member must be present for the duration of your visit to our site. Location fees, to cover staff time and to include a charitable donation to the maintenance of these precious places for wildlife, are detailed.

Note: Some of our sites are ASSI's (Areas of Special Scientific Interest). These sites will require consent from NIEA (Northern Ireland Environment Agency), which Ulster Wildlife will apply for on your behalf. Significant lead-in times may apply.

Ulster Wildlife Location Fees

- £200 + VAT for a ½ day access
- £300 + VAT for a full day access

These prices are based on one staff member from Ulster Wildlife being present on site for the duration of filming. Additional staff time or staff required will be charged at £25 per hour. News, current affairs, non-commercial photography or filming related to our work is not charged.

- You will be required to provide a Risk Assessment and proof of Public Liability Insurance covering up to £10 million.
- Drones are not permitted on our nature reserves unless by prior written agreement. Additional fees may apply.
- Ulster Wildlife Nature Reserves must be left in the condition that they were in before filming unless otherwise specifically agreed.
- We reserve the right to refuse access if the filming may have a significant impact on the nature reserve or if Ulster Wildlife staff commitment to supporting the visit is excessive.
